Adverse Childhood Experiences:	Adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) are traumatic events that can have negative, life-long effects on behavior and health.
ODSS:	University of Kansas' Online Documentation and Support System , a collective impact and evaluation tool measuring community change as a result of the Coalition's strategies and activities.
